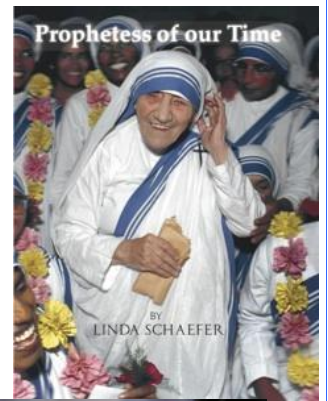


# Celebrating the Canonization of Mother Teresa

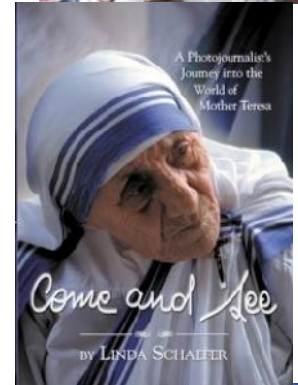
## Come and See

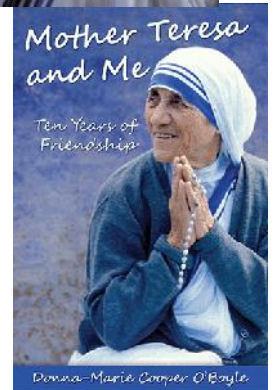


## Mother Teresa and Me - Ten Years of Friendship

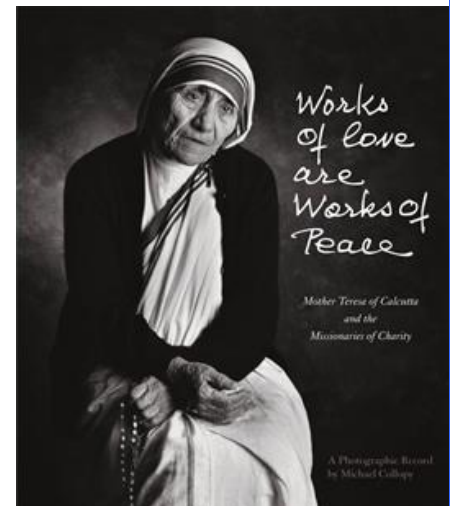


## Works of Love are Works of Peace

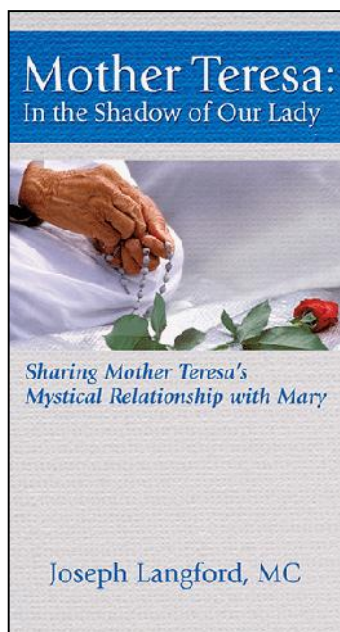

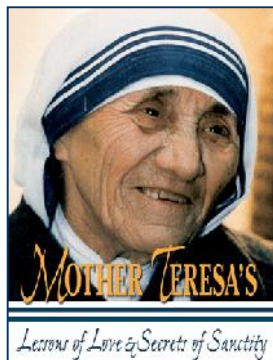

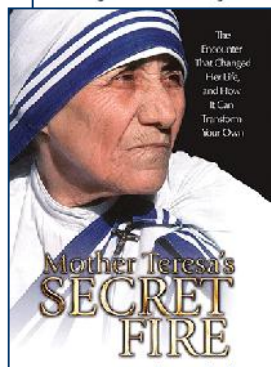


## Mother Teresa's Lessons of Love and Secrets of Sanctity Susan Conroy

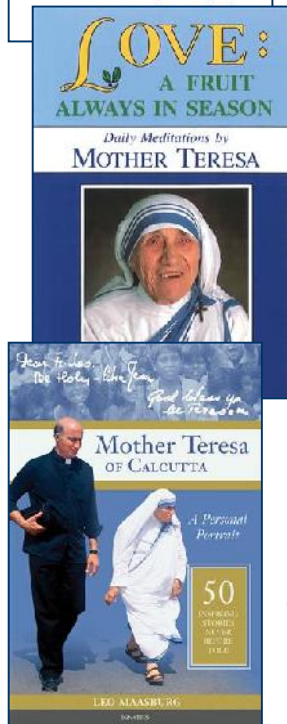
