Vladimir Nikolaevich Lossky, born in 1903, was not only seminal in the development of Orthodox theology in its Diaspora after the Russian Revolution, and a major figure in twentieth-century European theological history, but also one whose work can inspire a serious Christian life. This book is not only concerned with 'placing' Lossky within the world of patristic scholarship or the history of Russian religious thought, but rather, on Lossky's substantive spiritual teaching - and that of the teachers, especially ancient and mediaeval, he commended. Its principal intention is to communicate this teaching.
